
Centralized Notification

Supporting instant code call and rapid response notification at the facility's switchboard or centralized dispatch area, Provider 700 displays these urgent events at one or more locations through networked large screens or centralized staff console. The code and rapid response tones immediately direct attention to the active event while large screens display the room number and descriptive location. From central staff consoles, urgent calls from anywhere throughout the facility can be answered and confirmed before dispatching staff.

Wireless Crash Team Notification

Receiving critical information can be delayed or missed if your facility relies solely on public address announcements for emergency events. Provider 700's wireless alerts go directly to caregivers' smartphones, in-house SIP wireless phones, and/or pocket pagers. This means everyone on the crash team gets the same information at the same time. A single button press from anywhere in the facility instantly alerts the crash team with the room number and bed over their wireless devices. Provider 700's unique Group Alert technology alerts multiple smart or SIP phones simultaneously to an emergency event, eliminating the need for expensive middleware for group alerts.

These alerting options can be extended to other types of urgent patient and staff calls such as unit-wide "Staff Emergency" and "Bed Exit" alerts. Creating any number of custom team alerts ensures caregivers are immediately notified of all critical events so they can respond as quickly as possible.

Automated Announcements

Multiple zone outputs give you the flexibility to determine what areas should receive the announcement, while the "call canceled" announcement lets mobile caregivers know that an accidental call has been cleared.
